

## MY CALL

Galatians 1:2, “My call is from Jesus Christ himself and from God the Father who raised him from the dead.”

It is so very important for the servant of God to be reminded again and again who it was that called him into the ministry. For the life of Paul, he made it abundantly clear that his call was from no one else other than Jesus Christ, and God the Father. For the servant of God today who is a God called preacher, he must go back and be reminded that this same Jesus that called Paul is the same one who put him into the ministry.

Since it was Jesus Christ who put us into the ministry, it will be Jesus Christ who guides us, helps us, leads us, and equips us for whatever the journey involves. We may not know where the journey will lead us, but that is a minor thing to Christ. For he knows precisely where His call on our lives will take us! For Paul the call of God took him all over the world, traveling, moving from one place to another. That may or may not be the case with your life, but the wonder of God is that He will keep you all along the way....as you live in total dependence in Him.

As Paul was getting closer to the end of his life, he could look back and see God’s hand all along the way, and the same holds true today as well. If God has put you into the ministry, be reminded that He who begun a good work in you will continue it on day at a time, and He will give you strength for each new assignment that comes from heaven.
