## THE GIFT OF JESUS

## John 10:28, "And I give unto them eternal life; and they shall never perish, neither shall any man pluck them out of my hand."

Of all the gifts that could be given at Christmas time, all of them pale in comparison to the ultimate gift that Jesus desires to give to all mankind- the gift of eternal life.
